Scholarship is a Southeastern California Conference offering used to subsidize scholarships for worthy students in Transitional Kindergarten through 12th grade level in local SECC church schools and academies.

The K-12 offering is used by the Office of

Education to assist schools in providing assistance to families needing financial aid. This is done through the Low-Income Scholarship which will pay 10% of tuition and registration fees. That 10% is matched by the local school, allowing the recipient to receive 20% of his/her tuition and registration fees in the form of a scholarship.

plans are at the city for approval. Please mark your contributions, "Project, Solar" Thank you.


