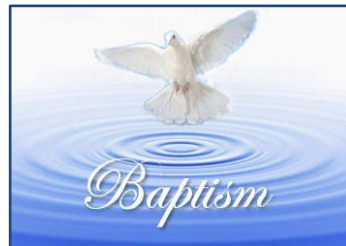
Receiving by Imparting
