FROM THE LIBRARY:

Focus on author **George Groth**



George describes himself as “an ordinary man who submitted to God’s voice, guidance, and infusion of the Holy Spirit.” His ministry in nursing, family leadership, and care for many children has been God directed. While working as a Psychiatric Nurse, George was inspired to write *A Guided Tour to Happiness*, a self-help booklet for his mental health patients. Later, while creating and managing in-patient psychiatric units, he wrote *Cook Book Psych.- Applied Mental Health Nursing*. This booklet helped integrate medical/surgical nurses into the world of psychiatric nursing.

For George, life has been a challenging adventure. A wilderness experience of living in a hollow redwood tree surrounded by a rainforest inspired him to write *It’s About Joy*. In vivid words, George continues the adventure exploring God’s creation and friendship with Jesus in Heaven.

Focus on author **Carolyn Stuyvesant**



By the time she was 7 years old, Carolyn had told Elder Arthur Maxwell, author of the Bedtime Stories that she wanted to write stories for African children. His encouragement through the years, and that of her English teacher mother, was what inspired her. While serving in Ethiopia from 1964 to 1974 as a teacher and nurse, Carolyn discovered that in all of East Africa there seemed to be no printed books containing true character-building African stories for African children. This was her opportunity.

Her source for some of these stories came directly from the African pastors and evangelists who she taught and with whom she worked. On vacations, she traveled to a dozen other African countries and continued interviewing and collecting stories. These became the five-book set of **Storytime in Africa**. The first two books were in the last Primary Missionary Volunteer Reading Course series in 1968 and 1969. The last three volumes were completed in the 1980’s. To date about 400,000 copies have been sold. The set belonging to the Yucaipa Church Library was printed in South Korea, one of 50,000 sets printed in 2011. They traveled in containers by way of the Red Sea to Mombassa, Kenya and were trucked to Nairobi. A pastor from Kenya brought them to Washington, D.C. last spring and they arrived here by the USPS. They have come a long way and are ready to be shared with our church family. Carolyn also wrote little books for the Quiet Hour, of which we have the one titled **Songs from the Heart**.
