Focus on author Gary Strunk



Several of Gary's contributions to the church have come through his interest in health and wellness. Many have attended his presentation In Pursuit of Excellence THE HEALTH COMPONENT. Complimenting this were two other presentations:

Taste of Nature Vegetarian Cooking School and The Natural Way to Weight Control. His book Grieving for a Smoke traces the grief response associated with smoking cessation, and helps the reader understand the physical and psychological components of addiction.

Gary authored the book Judge Me Please. Within its pages we see how and why the Great Controversy will be completed through Christ's work as biblical judge. In 2022 Jesus, Lord of Nations was published. This




