FROM THE LIBRARY:

Focus on musician **Dona Klein**: A Song from the Heart



Dona was the last of five children in an Adventist Christian family. She recalls falling asleep listening to her parents singing and playing old gospel songs. Those songs became the strong influence on her life and her music. When she was six years old, a family friend who owed her father money, asked to pay the debt with either a television set or a church organ. Thankfully, Dona's father chose the organ. And so began her life of music.

Dona played for her first evangelistic series at the age of twelve, and realized that was what the Lord was calling her to do. The Lord opened the door for her to play for many evangelists in and out of the country. She traveled with her husband, Gordon, and the Rodgers organ. The organ "has millions of missionary miles on it," she says. Dona and Gordon joined the Kenneth Cox Evangelistic Association in 1986, and although Gordon passed away in 2009, Dona has continued to serve with this ministry. Over the years, she has played for numerous camp meetings, the Rose City Singers/Heritage Singers, the Voice of Prophecy, It Is Written, the Quiet Hour, and for many other talented musicians. She has also made many television appearances and, for sixteen years, played for the KSGN radio program "An Evening Prayer." Being invited to play for the General Conference Sessions has fulfilled a life-long dream of Dona's. And of course, her home church, Yucaipa, continues to be blessed with her musical talents. Dona has recorded over forty gospel music albums for Chapel Music. The Yucaipa Church Library has several recordings available for check-out.

Focus on musician Curtis Bradford, Pastor and Evangelist



The Bradford family consisted of father Merl, mother Eva, two sons and four daughters. A tragic drowning took the lives of the two young boys. Merl's mother, a spiritual medium and follower of Satan, tried to convince sorrowing Eva that she could keep her sons through the "spirit world." But a Seventh-day Adventist neighbor showed Eva what the Bible taught about death. After Bible studies, Eva joined the Adventist Church. With nine years since the birth of her last daughter, Eva was surprised to find she was expecting another baby. Shocked,

Merl hoped for a son, a son who could sing! The birth of son, Curtis, brought joy to their family. And, yes, he was given the gift of singing.

Curtis rarely sang secular songs as he didn't feel that was his calling, He loved and enjoyed singing songs for the glory of God. Through the Holy Spirit, Curtis led hundreds of people to Christ through preaching and song. He sang for many evangelistic meetings, including H.M.S. Richards, Jr. and Kenneth Cox. He was also the evangelist for Southeastern California Conference and the Oregon Conference. He was involved in evangelism all over the United States and in a few countries. Curtis had several record albums that have now been put on **CDs** and are available for check-out at the church library. Curtis passed away in 2016, but his beautiful voice continues to bless others. He loved people and with his gentle spirit dedicated his life to the service of the Lord. He now awaits the resurrection and the coming of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
