

FROM THE LIBRARY: God leads in Life's Experiences

Focus on David and Janet Wilkins:



Dr. David and Janet Wilkins have lived in the Yucaipa area many years and are longtime members of the Calimesa Seventh-day Adventist Church. In 2003 David published the book **United by Tragedy** with co-author Cecil Murphy. Encouraged that the relating of this tragic experience might be helpful to others, he shares his family's intensely personal story of losing a son. This is the family's journey through grieving, questioning God, and finally receiving comfort from people who didn't know them, but knew their pain, and reached out to share in their suffering. They discovered that even in our

deepest darkness, God does not leave us alone. The loss will never go away, but neither will He.

Focus on author Stephanie Bowers Griffin MSN, RN, PHN



Stephanie was once a nurse who thrived in the ER, but now is a school nurse with a passion for studying the Word of God and leading a ladies weekly Bible study.

For almost nine years Stephanie was deeply involved in Spiritual Formation teachings and practices. She had a Spiritual Director during those years and was on the way to becoming one herself. She completed two and a half years of a three-year training program for becoming a Spiritual Director and was also enrolled in a Master's in Spiritual Formation Degree curriculum.

Then God intervened.

Since being delivered from the depths of this false revival and mystical practices, God has given her greater understanding of the dangers and erroneous teachings that Spiritual Formation encompasses.
