FROM THE LIBRARY:

Focus on author Kenneth Cox: A Service for the Lord



Kenneth Cox was the director and speaker of the Kenneth Cox Ministries located in Yucaipa, California, and a member of the Yucaipa SDA Church. He attended Union College in Lincoln, Nebraska where he majored in Theology and History. Kenneth received his Master of Divinity from Potomac University in Tacoma Park, Maryland.

In the early years of his work as an evangelist, it was his

innovative use of multiple screens and projectors that paved the way for what we know today as multi-media evangelism. He held evangelistic meetings on every continent and in over twenty different countries. At present, there are six of his evangelistic series that are now available on DVD and are used worldwide. His weekly television program, "Give Me the Bible" was seen on 3ABN and major television stations across the nation.

Elder Cox specialized in world history, and over the years, gave careful and detailed study to the Biblical prophecies and their relationship to last day events. He authored three books on Bible prophecy: **Revelation Pure and Simple**, Daniel **Pure and Simple**, and Four **Winds of Revelation**. His books on Biblical beliefs include: **Sanctuary Pure and Simple**, **In the Master's Steps**, and **Quick Bible Answers**. The book, **Called to Serve**, is the autobiography of his calling and life of service for the Lord.

Dorothy and Gerald remain impassioned in their mission to share and encourage others with the musical gifts God has imparted to them. Currently, Dr. Gerald Wareham is medical director of California Imaging & Diagnostics (outpatient Imaging Corporation).


